





# Collaboration between Finnish and US researchers Science Across Virtual Institute (SAVI)

- Funding collaboration between Academy of Finland, The Finnish Funding Agengy for Technology and Innovation (Tekes), and NSF
- Objective: to enhace collaboration in a field of common high interest
- Bottom up approach: based on an emerged need for cooperation in the field
- Funding for strenghtening existing collaboration



## Wireless Innovation Between Finland and US (WiFiUS)

Six projects: collaboration between three Finnish and eight US universities and institutes

- Coordination: Finnish and US coordinators
  - ✓ Physical and virtual student investigator meetings: Summer school 2012
  - ✓ Physical and virtual PI meetings: First US-Finland PI meeting 2012
  - ✓ A web portal providing services and content
  - ✓ Graduate student exchange

## Financing

Academy of Finland and Tekes fund Finnish participants NSF funds US participants, funding for two years
